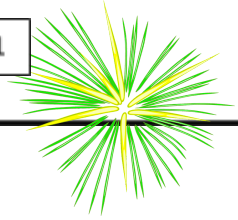

Kindergarten Registration for Neighbourhood Schools

Kindergarten registration for neighbourhood schools is from: February 15, 2021 until February 26, 2021 (9:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM). Parents are strongly encouraged to register children for kindergarten on these dates. To be eligible for attendance in kindergarten in September 2021, a student must be five years of age by December 31, 2021. Please bring your child's original birth certificate, BC Services Card and proof of address with you when registering as well as any legal documentation concerning custody (if applicable). Registration takes place at your neighbourhood school based on catchment boundaries. If you are unsure where to register, contact the School Board Office at 250-374-0679.

Daily Health Assessment

Please note that families are expected to continue to complete a daily health assessment with their children prior to going to school each day. Please see the daily health check guidelines sent home this week (for you to keep to refer to each day). Each student also requires an updated health assessment form to be signed and returned as soon as possible. **Please sign it and return to school as soon as possible.**

Please note that visitor access to our school campus continues to be limited. Parent access is only permitted when it is prearranged with the classroom teacher or school office.
